

B. (Paris / Spain)









B. (Paris / Spain) We might go to Paris, or we might go to Spain. We really can't decide.











A. When are they going to clean their apartment?


(today / tomorrow morning) They might clean it today, or they might clean it tomorrow. They really can't decide.
