# EXAMPLE



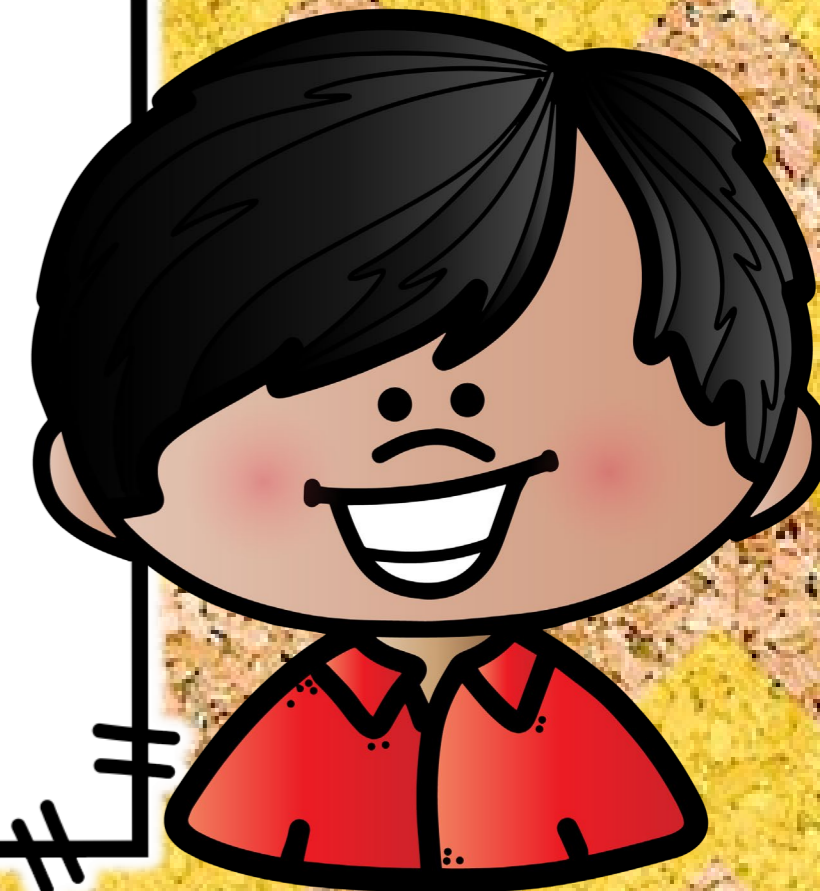


Alan always rides \_\_\_\_\_ bike
