

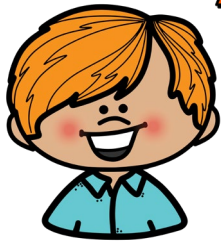

My neighbor is very **friendly**.



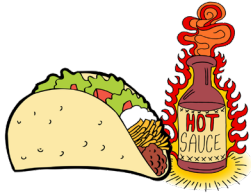
3. EXCITING

My children think the circus is **exciting**.



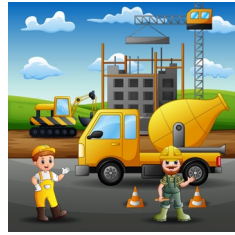
6. HOSPITABLE

They need a **powerful** machine to build the house.



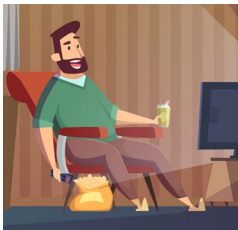
8. INTELLIGENT / SMART

Everybody says my students are **talented**.



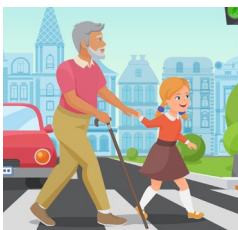
10. LIGHT
