

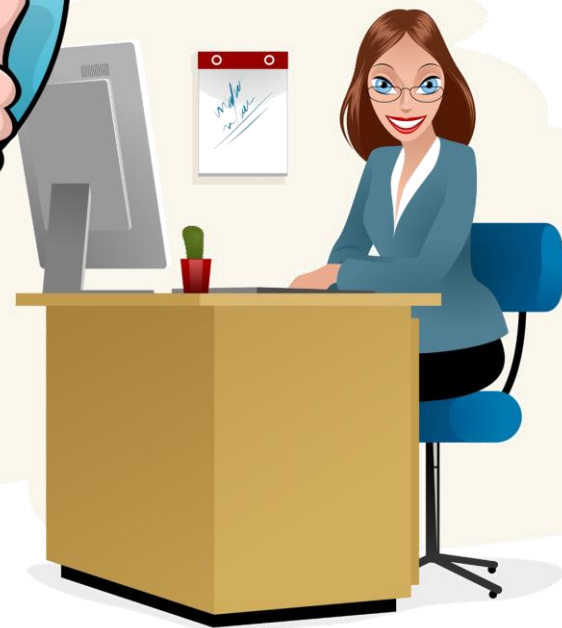

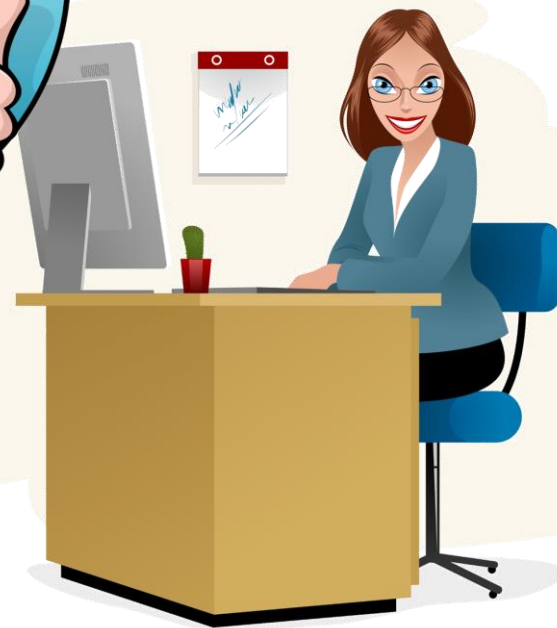
My brother works in a bakery.

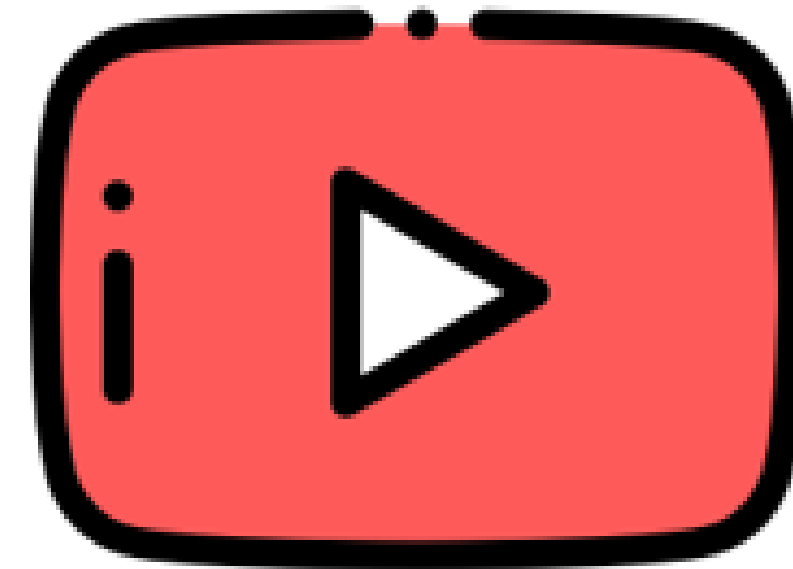
