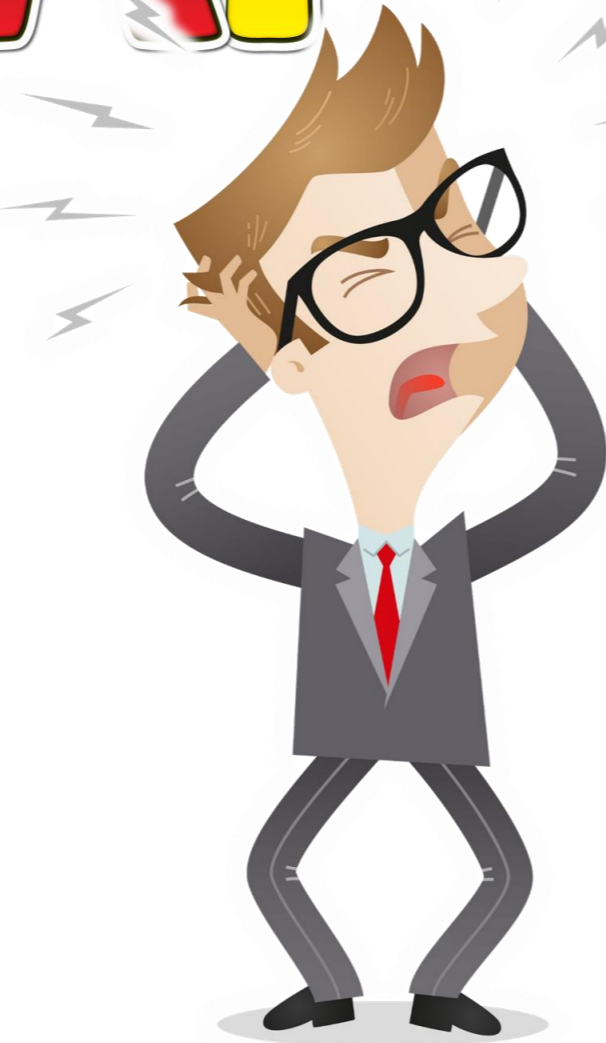


A TERRIBLE DAY AT WORK

usually sells them is on vacation.**



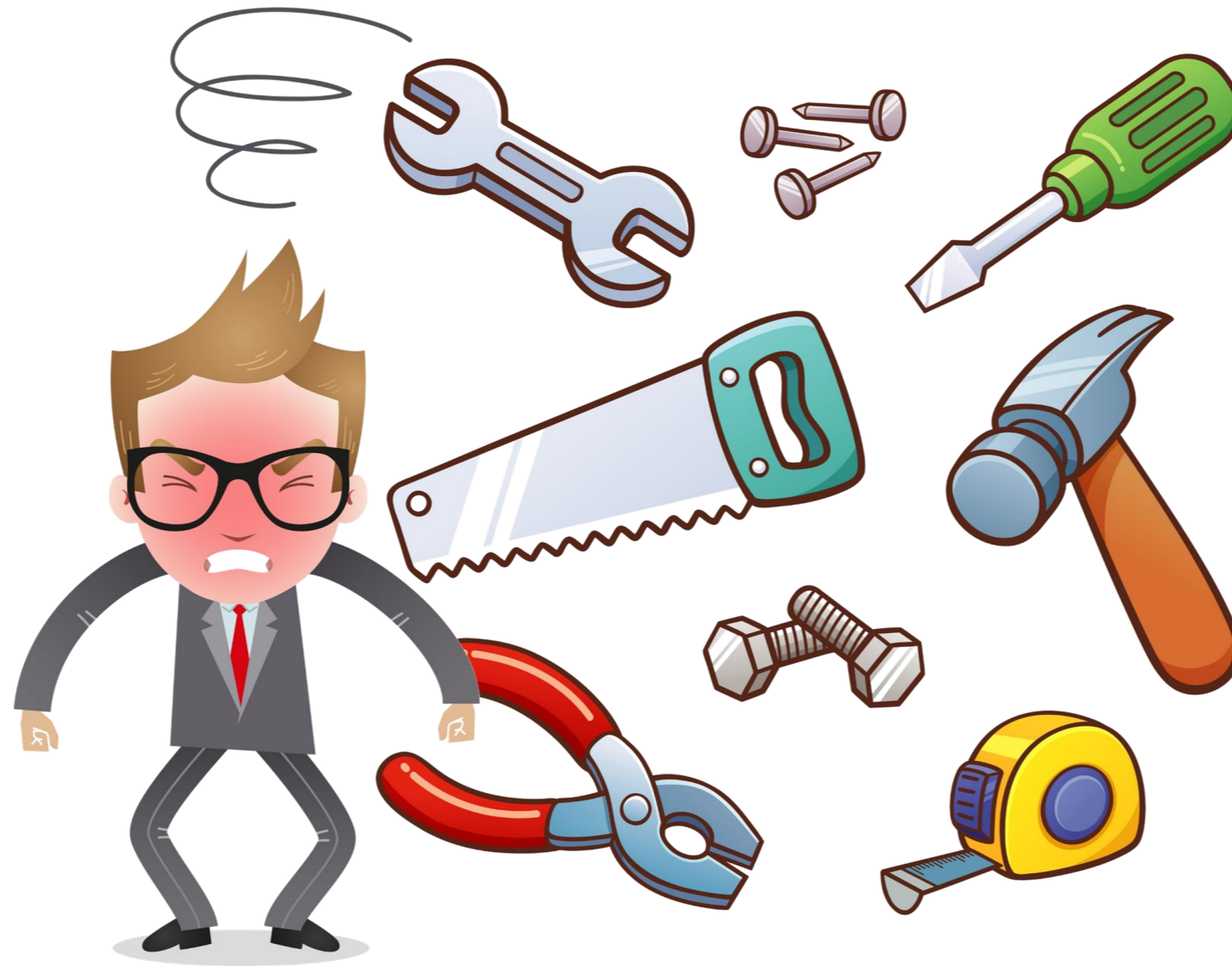
**He's using the cash register

usually cleans it is on strike.**

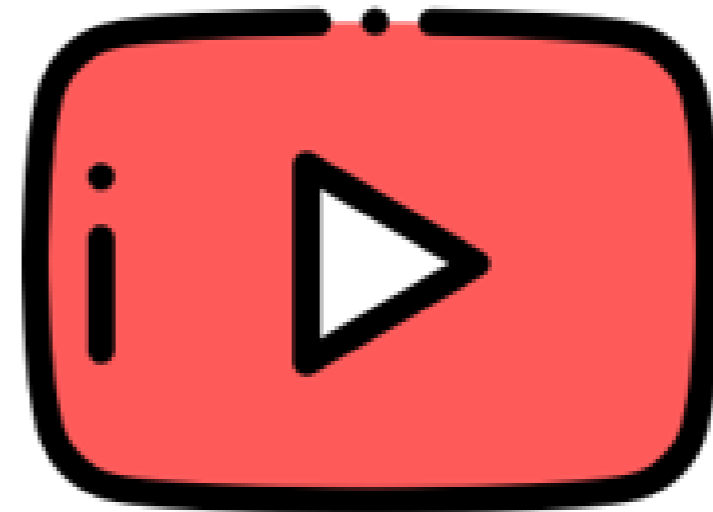


Poor Mr. Miller! It's a very busy day at the hardware store and he's very stressed out.
