Continuous Tenses Progressive

Present Continuous

✓	}	Am I	• I <u>am</u> eating.
-		Is He, She, It	• <u>Is</u> she cooking?
?		Are We, You, They	• We <u>aren't</u> studying.

Past Continuous

✓	}	Was I, He, She, It	• It <u>was</u> sleeping.
-		Were We, You, They	• They <u>weren't</u> working.

AUXILIARY VERB "HAVE"

Perfect Tenses

Present Perfect } Have I, We, You, They • I have ^{read} read.
Perfect } Has He, She, It • It hasn't snowed.

Past Perfect } Had I, You, He, • I hadn't studied.
Perfect } She, It, We, • Had they
They bought the books?
