



# TIME EXPRESSIONS **FOR & SINCE** PRESENT PERFECT

## **FOR**

is used with expressions describing a period of time.



She's gone to the same hair salon **FOR** many years.



He's had a stomachache **FOR** three days.

## **SINCE**

is used with expressions describing a definite point in time.



She hasn't seen her friends **SINCE** 2020.



I haven't eaten ice cream **SINCE** I started my diet.
