**Question:** Have you been treating pets' injuries since 2019?

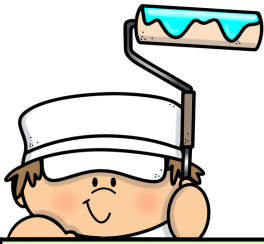

**Question:** Have I been classifying books for five hours?

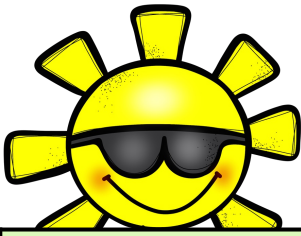
