

# PAST PERFECT TENSE



SUBJECT	AUXILIARY HAD	PAST PARTICIPLE	COMPLEMENT.
1. They	had	crossed	the bridge <b>before</b> they got to the school bus.

**Contraction:** They'd crossed the bridge.

**Negative Sentence:** They had not crossed the bridge.  
They hadn't crossed the bridge.

**Question:** Had they crossed the bridge?



SUBJECT	AUXILIARY HAD	PAST PARTICIPLE	COMPLEMENT.
2. He	had	gone	fishing <b>before</b> he made lemon grilled salmon.

**Contraction:** He'd gone fishing.

**Negative Sentence:** He had not gone fishing.  
He hadn't gone fishing.

**Question:** Had he gone fishing?



SUBJECT	AUXILIARY HAD	PAST PARTICIPLE	COMPLEMENT.
3. She	had	charged	her camera battery <b>before</b> she went on a walk in nature.

**Contraction:** She'd charged her camera battery.

**Negative Sentence:** She had not charged her camera battery.  
She hadn't charged her camera battery.

**Question:** Had she charged her camera battery?



SUBJECT	AUXILIARY HAD	PAST PARTICIPLE	COMPLEMENT.
4. I	had	put on	my earphones <b>before</b> I went for a run.

**Contraction:** I'd put on my earphones.

**Negative Sentence:** I had not put on my earphones.  
I hadn't put on my earphones.

**Question:** Had I put on my earphones?



SUBJECT	AUXILIARY HAD	PAST PARTICIPLE	COMPLEMENT.
5. You	had	packed	your suitcase <b>before</b> you went to the airport.

**Contraction:** You'd packed your suitcase.

**Negative Sentence:** You had not packed your suitcase.  
You hadn't packed your suitcase.

**Question:** Had you packed your suitcase?



SUBJECT	AUXILIARY HAD	PAST PARTICIPLE	COMPLEMENT.
6. We	had	visited	the plant nursery <b>before</b> we restored our garden.

**Contraction:** We'd visited the plant nursery.

**Negative Sentence:** We had not visited the plant nursery.  
We hadn't visited the plant nursery.

**Question:** Had we visited the plant nursery?



SUBJECT	AUXILIARY HAD	PAST PARTICIPLE	COMPLEMENT.
7. It	had	been	clean <b>before</b> it rolled in the mud.

**Contraction:** It'd been clean.

**Negative Sentence:** It had not been clean.  
It hadn't been clean.

**Question:** Had it been clean?
