The basket is full of **red** apples.



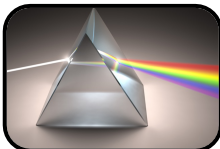
WHICH ONE?

Do you want to go to an **Italian** restaurant?



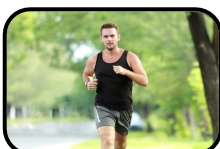
WHAT MATERIAL IS IT MADE OF?

The house is **small**.



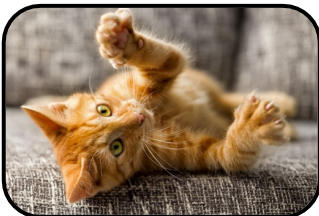
I have a **blue** jacket.
My jacket is **blue**.



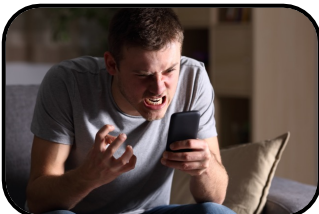
I'm eating a **delicious** ice cream.
