## Perfect Modal Verbs



### MIGHT

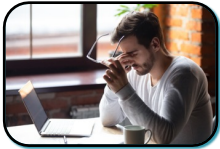
The past form of the modal might is:  
MIGHT HAVE + THE PAST PARTICIPLE

We use it to talk about a **small** possibility in the past.

### MAY

The past form of the modal may is:  
MAY HAVE + THE PAST PARTICIPLE

We use it to talk about a **greater** possibility in the past.



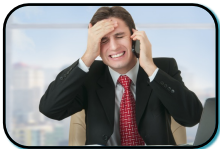
1. He might / may have lost his job.  
He might / may not have been responsible.



2. The landlord might / may have evicted them from the apartment.  
They might / may not have had enough money.



3. She might / may have misplaced the merchandise.  
She might / may not have been careful.



4. I might / may have forgotten to send the email.  
I might / may not have even written it.



5. The car might / may have broken down in the middle of the road.  
The car might / may not have had enough gas.



6. She might / may have received awful news.  
She might / may not have expected that text message.



7. He might / may have driven drunk after the party.  
He might / may not have seen the other car.



8. The girls might / may have made fun of Julie at school.  
They might / may not have treated her with respect.
