MUST

The past form of the modal verb must is:

MUST HAVE • THE PAST PARTICIPLE

We use it to express strong probability about the past.

WHEN I GOT TO THE PARTY, MY BOYFRIEND WASN'T THERE.
He must've gotten lost on his way to the party.



WE HAD A SURPRISE PARTY FOR MY BEST FRIEND, BUT SHE WASN'T SURPRISED.

John must've told her about the party.

BETTY GOT THE HIGHEST GRADE ON THE SCIENCE TEST.
She must've spent hours getting ready for the test.



DANIEL AND MARK MISSED SOCCER PRACTICE.
Their Mom must've picked them up early today.



I SAW SARAH DRIVING ON MONDAY, BUT SHE DOESN'T HAVE A CAR.
Her parents must've given her a car as a graduation present.



RYAN AND AMY ALWAYS HAND IN THEIR HOMEWORK ON TIME, BUT THEY DIDN'T THIS MORNING.

They must've left it in the library by mistake.

She must've been exhausted after working all night.

Your daughter must've played with all her toys.
