

# OCCUPATIONS - PART 6



1. **BUSSER:** A busser is a restaurant worker who is responsible for clearing tables and preparing them for the next customers.



2. **CASHIER:** A cashier works in a store and handles customer transactions. They use a cash register to ring up purchases, make change, and provide receipts.



3. **FARMER:** A farmer works in agriculture to grow crops and raise animals for food and other products.



4. **HOST/HOSTESS:** A host or hostess welcomes guests or customers in a hospitality setting, such as a restaurant, hotel, or event venue.



5. **MAID:** A maid performs different cleaning tasks, such as dusting, vacuuming, washing dishes, doing laundry, and changing bedding.



6. **MANAGER:** A manager oversees a group of employees or a department in a company. They set goals, delegate tasks, and support their team.



7. **POLITICIAN:** A politician is elected by people to make decisions in the government or public affairs.



8. **SURGEON:** A surgeon is a medical doctor who performs operations to treat injuries, diseases, and deformities.



9. **TAILOR:** A tailor makes, alters, and fixes clothes using scissors and sewing machines. They work with fabrics like cotton, silk, or wool.



10. **PERSONAL TRAINER:** A personal trainer is a health and wellness professional who works with individuals one-on-one to help them achieve their fitness goals.



11. **TRANSLATOR:** A translator converts written or spoken words from one language into another language, conveying the same meaning and context.



12. **TRAVEL AGENT:** A travel agent helps people plan and book their travel, including flights, hotels, tours, and transportation to different places.
