

ADVERBS OF MANNER

Adverbs of manner describe how an action is performed.

RULE 1: An adverb of manner is formed by adding **-ly** to the corresponding adjective.



1.
He's an efficient painter.
He paints efficiently.



2.
She's a patient teacher.
She teaches patiently.



3.
He's a polite driver.
He drives politely.



4.
He's a fair judge.
He judges fairly.



5.
They're creative editors.
They edit creatively.

RULE 2: For adjectives that end in **-y**, the **-y** changes to **-i** and **-ly** is added.



6.
She's an angry player.
She plays angrily.



7.
They're happy cheerleaders.
They cheer happily.



8.
He's a lazy cook.
He cooks lazily.

IRREGULAR ADVERBS: There are several irregular adverbs of manner.



9.
He's a good coach.
He coaches well.



10.
They're hard workers.
They work hard.



11.
She's a fast skater.
She skates fast.



12.
They're loud singers.
They sing loudly.
