In this conversation, a supervisor at a hotel checks in with their employee, Jessie, to ensure that all the tasks have been completed.


SUPERVISOR

Can you tell me more about the rooms that have been cleaned?





JESSIE

All the floors on the first and second floors have been swept and mopped. They are now clean and ready for guests to walk on.




SUPERVISOR
